Foam Xylophone Visual

Needed: For 1 Visual

1 - 12x18 sheet in Brown or Black (for background)

Doubled sided Velco (sticky on one side to stick to the back ground and bar the other has the little hooks) I found a big role of this as Walmart- and then I just cut little squares. Much cheaper to do this than to buy the squares or circles at an Office Supply Store.

I purchased the big 12x 18 sheets in the above colors and cut the bar sizes as listed above. This made many visuals....I'm thinking 10 but I don't remember exactly.

I started just by cutting $1 \frac{1}{4}$ strips out of each color and then cut the length down to what I needed.

Then I went assembly style with laying all of the colors on a Brown back – attaching the velco and flipping them over to stick but what ever works best for you- you'll find a system when you are doing so many ©

I used a stencil and sharpie to add the letter to the middle of the bar but you wouldn't have to do that.

Don't forget the accidentals! F# and Bb - I put those with Velcro on the back

We charged \$10.00 for each one and sold out- made a great profit for the chapter

If you are a quilter or have a friend who is a quilter....the rotary cutter was super fast to cut the strips.
